1.1	What progress have you made on your Inclusive data priorities/ IDC Action Plan priorities in the past year?	Include examples to accompany any highlights or achievements.	We implemented the CUIRDATA project, aimed at raising awareness and providing technical support to civil society organizations (CSOs) and government bodies for collecting data on the LGBTQI+ population in Ecuador and Latin America. We also participated in regional events and held local workshops with Ecuador's Ministry of Women and Human Rights to explore the inclusion of SOGIESC variables in administrative records across 24 public institutions.  In addition, we have actively promoted the participation of women in data collection processes in collaboration with local CSOs. This included two data collection

			initiatives in different cities of Ecuador, focusing on women's perceptions of well-being in their urban environments.  Lastly, we have encouraged the involvement of youth and adolescents in digital skills development and responsible use of technology. We organized data walks in two cities, allowing young people to gather data about their neighborhoods, promoting their active engagement in data-driven community improvement efforts.

In addition, since 2021 we have also collaborated with Paris 21, to promote the inclusion of a gender approach to data visualization initiatives with NSOs and CSOs in different countries in Latin America through virtual and in-person workshops.
