Include examples to accompany any highlights or achievements.	<p>Progresses have been made concerning the streamlining of data disaggregation in core IMPACT analytical outputs such as the MSNI bulletin (related to multisectoral research) where we made it mandatory to disaggregate by several demographic criteria, some core, some optional. Criteria included gender and age of HoH, disability status, income.</p> <p>In parallel progress has been made regarding developing complementary research to focus on marginalized groups such as children or LGBTQIA+ communities. Guidance has been developed based on a pilot research with LGBTQIA+ individuals which aims</p>



			<p>to support the replication of such exercises in other contexts.</p> <p>Global-level advocacy towards inclusive research has been done in several platforms such as the HNPW (presentation on disability data) and UN World Data Forum (panel on children on the move, presentation on inclusion of marginalized groups through mixed methods approaches)</p>

Piloting such approaches also requires additional funding to conduct proper research and development and build knowledge based on pilot initiatives.</p>
