This can also include any COVID-19 related reflections	 Greater inclusion of the WGQ in data collection instruments Increase in requests for support to produce disability- disaggregated statistics Established gender focal points provide support in relation to mainstreaming gender and disability analysis All COVID-19 rapid needs assessments conducted during February-August 2020 collected data on the situation of older people with disabilities, demonstrating high share of individuals across different age cohorts with more than 3 types of impairments. Data was disaggregated in the intersection of sex, age and disability displaying diversity and inequalities within the older population. This granular evidence was also used to study the role of assistive products in building resilience of sub-groups of older people across six Asia-Pacific countries. HelpAge struggled to improve analysis of the collected data on disability and 'translation' of this evidence into programmatic/advocacy impact in a consistent and meaningful way. Additionally, findings are rarely fed back to the survey participants for transparency and accountability purposes. This is due to limited statistical expertise, availability of user-friendly tools, low capacity and lack of funding.

Yes. In September 2020, HelpAge took part in the Disability Knowledge Exchange where we presented lessons from administering COVID-19 Rapid Needs Assessments for older women and men, including older people with disabilities. We shared with other Champions successes and challenges in our approaches to data collection, analysis and dissemination. In August 2020, HelpAge shared its experience of measuring disability of older people in a humanitarian context with the Internal Displacement Monitoring Centre.
