IGH has embedded inclusive data across our programs. This includes working with stakeholders in our Vanguard Program to expand the use of the inclusive data and participatory data approaches. We have also embedded enumerating homelessness with disaggregated data in Vanguard Program foundational documents. We have worked to share a toolkit on disaggregated data and resource guide on partnering with people of lived experience. We have also had public events that featured calls for inclusive data including with UN-Habitat partners.
